

Books sent home for reading

Your child will take home two books. One of these books will be a phonetically decodable book in line with the sounds they have been taught in class (see 'Tip Tap' example below). This book is to be read by your child to an adult. Your child needs to segment and blend the sounds to read the words, as well as reading by sight the 'harder to read' words. Your child should be encouraged to read this as independently as possible.

The other book will be their reading for pleasure book which is from our school library (see 'What the Ladybird Heard' example below). This book should be read by an adult to your child. Please enjoy this book together; discussing the characters, setting and making predictions about what may happen next in the story!



You will also be given a password to access online fully decodable books, these books will also match the sounds being currently taught in class. You will be able to find this password in the back of your child's orange, reading record book.
